

WEST SURREY LADIES BOWLING LEAGUE

RULES

1. The date by which entries to the league shall be set by the Committee.
2. The draws and round dates shall be made by the League Committee.
3. The clubs whose name appears first shall be deemed the home side and the challengers.
4. Each round shall consist of two triples of eighteen ends, at home or away on a 2 year programme. If there is no possibility of booking rinks the game can both be played on the opponents green remembering to reverse the fixture the following year.
5. No trial ends. One shot only on the first two ends.
6. One point for each winning triple.
Half a point for a draw.
Two points for an overall win
One point for an overall draw
7. The home team will phone or email the result of the match to the League Secretary. Keep result cards until the end of the season in case there may be any discrepancies.
8. If a game is conceded, or a team fails to arrive, the opposition may claim the game and will be awarded 4 (four) points and 10 (ten) shots.
9. Clubs are expected to fulfil all their fixtures. Failure to complete 2/3 (two thirds) of their games the club membership to the league will be reviewed at the AGM.
10. Any lady with membership to more than one club can only represent one within the West Surrey Ladies Bowling League.
11. If play is stopped due to bad weather and the combined ends played (across the two triples) is 20 then the score to stand as a result. If less than 20 ends played the game to be rearranged before the next round and in accordance with Bowls England Rules. If a mutual date cannot be agreed within the time scale the points will be shared.
