There are also forms on the wall which will need to be completed advising where any food was purchased or supplied from and signed by those on tea duties or running the coffee mornings.

Please also refer to "The Cakemakers Guide - Advice on Preparing Cakes at Home" which she would be grateful if we could read. This will also apply to anybody offering a cake for coffee mornings. There will also be a copy in the kitchen for your perusal.

Rachel has also suggested that we should separate our rubbish and have a recycling and non-recycling bin. Kindly ensure that the correct items are placed in the correct bin.
